Fabric Architecture I - 3 hour session

- Pencil and eraser
- Paper scissors
- Glue stick
- A magazine with pictures having quality color combinations e.g. "House Beautiful", "Architectural Digest", "Travel", "Auto", "National Geographic", "Gardening".

Sewing Tools & Machine are NOT required for this session

Fabric Architecture II - 3 hour session

- Thread - taupe or heather gray
- Fabric Selections - ¼ to ½ yard each
5 or more different selections
- More selections for more intricate piecing
- Flannel, 100% cotton - ½ yard
- Sewing Tools & Machine as listed in sidebar

The instructor offers a \$25.00 fabric kit.

Fabric Architecture III - 6 hour session*

- Completed piecing from Class II
- Pattern or project plan, repaired as much as possible
Such as pattern pieces cut out and ready for fitting
- Mother Fabric purchased
- Related notions, including Interfacing
- Sewing Tools & Machine as listed in sidebar

* There is a 1 hour lunch break to renew the mind and body.

Sewing Tools

BSR or Free Motion Foot such as foot #9 or #29

#10 Foot (This is a must if you own a Bernina. Please bring an all-purpose foot for satin stitching if you own another brand of machine.)

Knee Lift Lever (if you have one)

Thread Snips**

General Sewing Supplies

Include scissors, snips, seam ripper, tape measure or quilters rule, rotary cutter (optional), extra sewing machine needles, hand sewing needles, pins, & any other favorite tools. Consider what is lying around your machine at home and bring those items.

Sewing Machine

In Good Working Condition

- Include power cord, foot pedal and attachments.

- PLEASE clean and oil before class, as this is a machine intensive project. Consider cleaning and oiling after class as well.
