Supply List

4-6 napkins – $\frac{3}{4}$ yards of 2 different fabrics

2-3 napkins – $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of 2 different fabrics

$\frac{3}{4}$ yds. of 2 different fabrics

1 spool of serger thread or construction thread,**

1spool of decorative thread ie: wooley nylon,** Metallic wooley

nylon,** Razzle Dazzle,* pearl crown,** jean stitch, **

Varigated threads do wonderful things.

Sewing Tools

HR FIVE OR 505 temporary spray*

Shears—its difficult to cut circles with rotary cutters but if
you choose you may use one.

General Sewing Supplies

1 spool of serger thread or construction thread**

1spool of decorative thread (Wooly nylon**, Metallic wooly
nylon**, Razzle Dazzle*, pearl crown**, Jean Stitch**)

Variegated threads (Valdani*, Madeira*, Superior Rainbows*)
do wonderful things.

Include threads, scissors, extra sewing machine needles,
scissors, straight pins, seam ripper, tape measure or quilters
rule, and any other favorite tools. Consider what is lying around
your machine at home and bring those items.

Serger Machine

- All items that came with your serger
- Include power cord, foot pedal and attachments.
- PLEASE clean and oil before class, as this is a machine
intensive project. Consider cleaning and oiling after class as
well.
